

# WFHESL Testing FAQs

## When is testing?

April 28th and 29th Grades 3-8 / April 29 Grades 9-12\*

Charity Chapel 5820 Montgomery Ave, Pensacola

Go through the front door of the main church building.

May 5th and 6th Grades 3-8 / May 6th Grades 9-12\*

Pinewoods Presbyterian 2198 County Rd 297A, Cantonment

Go through the door under the pavilion.

## \*High School Single Day ONLY

**ALL** High School Testing will be a single day this year from 9:00 am to 2:15pm. High school

High school students will be tested on the second day of testing at each location.

## How do I register?

Complete the online registration form at [www.wfheshl.org](http://www.wfheshl.org) You will see the testing listed in the **Events** tab.

## WFHESL Members

Sign into the website and use the **Members Only** form to receive the member discount. If you do not sign in and use the proper form, you will be charged non-member prices for testing.

## Non-WFHESL Members

Click "Test Registration 2025" on the main screen.

## Payment

Pay immediately after registering. Follow the instructions on the league web site on the second step of registration. Payment must be made at time of registration.

## Who can test?

Although this test is intended for children of WFHESL members, children of non-members may test for an additional fee.

## What ages are tested?

Grades 3 – 12

## Can my child test if they are in 2<sup>nd</sup> grade?

Yes, they may take the 3<sup>rd</sup> grade test if they are a strong reader and are comfortable being away from their parents for 4½ hours.

## How much does testing cost?

\$25.00 per student for current WFHESL members.

\$45.00 per student for non-WFHESL members.

\$10.00 per student for an evaluation based on test scores (**OPTIONAL**).

## Why would I want to pay for an evaluation based on test scores?

If you select this option, an evaluation letter based on your child's test scores will be mailed to you with the results. This costs \$10 per child. This letter can be submitted to your school district to satisfy the annual evaluation requirement.
